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Summit group named a world-changer

College Summit, a national nonprofit preparing to serve more than 200 students in South Carolina beginning this summer, has been named by a leading business magazine as one of the "top 25 groups that are changing the world."

For the second consecutive year, Fast Company magazine and Monitor Group selected College Summit, an organization working to increase college enrollment rates for low-income students across the country, as a recipient of the 2005 Social Capitalist Awards in its January 2005 issue.

Fast Company and Monitor picked College Summit from among 118 organizations after a five-month analysis.

This summer, the USC is hosting the first College Summit workshop in the state, where rising high school seniors will complete their entire college portfolio, and community leaders will evaluate the effectiveness of the program.
